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
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# Monitoring of INTERADIS project by Ukrainian national Erasmus+ Office



1 October 2021, the monitoring of EU Erasmus+ project INTERADIS International Students Adaptation and Integration (619451-EPP-1-2020-1-NL-EPPKA2-CBHE-JP) was held online with moderation of V.N.Karazin Kharkiv National University with participation of the Ukrainian Universities, INTERADIS partners.

The monitoring program included:

- meeting with the Rectors/Vice-Rectors of the Ukrainian partner HEIs;
- summary of the achieved project results;
- presentation of each team project results, discussion of project key issues;
- communication with administrative and academic staff of the departments that work with international students;



# Celebration of the International Students' Day at NUWEE

Every year on November 17 the world celebrates the International Students' Day, a holiday of youth and life. Traditionally, this holiday is celebrated in the National University of Water and Environmental Engineering.

Rector Viktor Moshynskyi, Vice-Rector for Research and International Affairs Nataliia Savina and all the staff of the Center for International Cooperation and Education, headed by Igor Tymoshchuk





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congratulated the NUWEE international students. A special guest of this event was the head of Rivne, the esteemed mayor Oleksandr Tretyak.

The Rector addressed the students with a welcoming speech, wishing them curiosity and new achievements. Natalia Savina, Vice-Rector for Research and International Affairs, in turn stressed the importance of student years in everyone's life, encouraged students to value this time and actively participate not only in the educational process but also in the socio-cultural life of the university.



Mayor of Rivne Oleksandr Tretiak addressed the students with a welcoming speech in Ukrainian and English, shared pleasant memories of his student years and the experience of volunteering in African countries.

Mr. Oleksandr Tretiak got acquainted with NUWEE international students who presented their creative achievements in Ukrainian with very heartfelt video presentations, took part in the interactive activities. During the event the Mayor also presented the initiated project for young people "Live, Study and Work in Rivne", which aims to develop the scientific, educational and cultural potential of our city, to make it more comfortable and inspiring place.

The event, organized by the Department for International Students Affairs, headed by Vladyslav Solodkyi, was aimed to bring together young people from different countries to establish intercultural communication and friendship, as well as to introduce students to Buddy volunteers who were selected within the INTERADIS project implementation.

So, casual communication, discussion on comfort and safety of study and living in the city of Rivne, as well as interesting competitions in a pile of goodies made it possible to remove barriers between





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International and Ukrainian students. The opportunity to learn more about cultures of other countries, to improve the knowledge of different languages and to lay the foundation for the implementation of various projects - this is what became the highlight of this holiday in NUWEE.



#### IS integration practices and experience at NUWEE

On October 27, 2021, an online meeting with 1-st year students in the mayor of Management was held by Professor Dmytro Nikitenko, participant of the working group of INTERADIS grant project "International Students Adaptation and Integration" (619451-ERR-1-2020-1-NL-EPPKA2-CBHE-JP).





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The international experience of adaptation and integration of international students on the example of Mykolas Romeris University (Vilnius, Lithuania) was presented at this meeting. Students expressed great interest in participating in the mentoring and / or buddy-program to implement better international students' adaptation practices at the NUWEE.



At the same time, the adaptation practices of NUWEE international students are being implemented. Thus, on October 27, 2021, NUWEE international students, Head of the Department for International Students Affairs Vladyslav Solodkyi and officers for the ISA Department, Olene Polishchuk and Olena Bryzhata visited Ukrainian Radio Rivne UA.

This visit was devoted to the Day of Ukrainian Literature and Language, which is celebrated annually in Ukraine on November 9. The team of Ukrainian Radio Rivne has joined the special project of the channel Suspilne "Speak Ukrainian Freely", which will be broadcast daily from October 27. Rivne audio stories are about people who have learned Ukrainian consciously, as it was not their mother tongue.

Our students from different parts of the world shared their stories of mastering the Ukrainian language. In particular, Atakarriev Muhammetguli (Turkmenistan), Elfeituri Hashim (Libya), Atari Younes (Morocco), Ovus Mensa Clinton (Ghana), Trujillo Mathias (Ecuador) told about difficulties they encountered on the way of studying Ukrainian, whether they use it in everyday life and about their plans to further improvement of their skills. #### **Online meeting with NUWEE Student Parliament**

On October 28, 2021, Dmytro Nikitenko, Andrii Podlevskyi, Krasovska Yuliana and Podlevska Oksana carried out an online meeting with NUWEE student parliament within INTERADIS grant project "International Students Adaptation and Integration" (619451-ERR-1-2020-1-NL-EPPKA2-CBHE-JP). It should be reminded that the project is implemented within the framework of Erasmus+ Capacity Building in the Field of Higher Education and is co-financed by the European Union.





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At the meeting, the project participants shared their foreign experience in creating a Students unit, which could be a focal point for the integration of international students into the NUWEE environment.

As a result of the meeting, the initiative to create a student organization, the scope of which would include issues of cooperation with international students, was supported.



#### Reporting workshop on the SV results to the Mykolas Romeris University

On October 22, 2021 there was in-depth discussion on the results of workshops in Yuriy Fedkovych Chernivtsi National University held on October 4-5, 2021 and study visit to Mykola Romeris University (Vilnius, Republic of Lithuania), which took place within the INTERADIS grant project "Integration and adaptation of foreign students" (619451-ERR-1-2020-1-NL-EPPKA2-CBHE-JP) during the period from October 10 to 16, 2021

Five representatives of the National University of Water and Environmental Engineering, namely: Vladyslav Solodkyi, Dmytro Nikytenko, Andrii Podlevskyi, Yuliana Krasovska and Oksana Podlevska, participated in the workshop in Chervtsi and study and training visit to Lithuania.

The main project goal is to expand and improve the capacity of higher education institutions of Ukraine in the field of international students' integration and adaptation. The Project is co-funded by the Erasmus+ Program of the European Union with the support of the National Erasmus + Office in Ukraine.

The first day of the study visit covered speeches of representatives of Lithuanian Erasmus + National Agency Vitalijus Zencenko and Greta Kiskiene, Head of the International Office of Mykolas Romeris University (MRU) Audra Dargyte Burokiene, Head of Head of Academic Affairs Centre Inga Dauksiene and Chief Manager for Incoming Students of the International Office Inesa Cvetkova.

Representatives of the Lithuanian Erasmus+ National Agency presented information on Ukraine's place in mobility programs in 2015-2020 and prospects for credit mobility in 2021-2027. Thus, in particular,





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the new stage envisages the introduction of such types of mobility as short-term, mixed and intensive mixed programs.

Audra Dargyte Burokiene, Head of the International Office of Mykolas Romeris University (MRU), presented information on changes in the organizational structure and staff functions of the International Office, who are involved in the process of internationalization of the University since 2016. The structure of the International office of the MRU is similar to our Center for International Cooperation and Education, which also includes departments dealing with credit mobility of domestic students, mobility of teachers, promotion and admission of international students and their support, reception of foreign delegations.

The main goals of the International Office of the MRU and the NUWEE Center for International Cooperation and Education are quite similar: to increase the number of international students (up to 10% of the total number of students), to improve the quality of students, to expand the geography of entrants; to increase the number of students on credit mobility.

Head of Academic Affairs Centre Inga Dauksiene presented its structure and main areas of work. Thus, unlike our Center and due to the peculiarities of migration legislation, the MRU has a Career center, which provides information to international students about possible jobs and available vacancies in the labor market. The instruments of international students' integration into the university environment are interesting. Introductory "0" week, meeting with graduates, supervision, mentoring, student government and the availability of a student guide contribute to smoother integration of international students.

During the introductory "0" week, international students in a clear and simple way integrate into the educational environment, get acquainted with the university infrastructure and values of the university, master the basic academic rules and living conditions, assessment of learning outcomes, curriculum features, etc.

Inesa Cvetkova, Chief Manager for Incoming Students of the International Office, presented detailed algorithm of the process for engaging international students, that is divided it into 2 stages: before arrival and after arrival at the university. What impressed our group the most was the availability of software that helps to digitalize the communication processes between the university and the applicant, starting with the application and ending with the settlement at the university.

The integration of international students upon arrival involves providing to the student a complete package of information on academic information (study schedule, call schedule), campus location, contact details and consultation times, emergency phone numbers, information on preventing the spread of coronavirus infection COVID-19, list possible socio-cultural events.

The work of staff with international students has its own peculiarities, and therefore in the MRU they follow this rule: "Think in two languages!"

Laura Stefanovych, President of the MRU Erasmus Student Network, described how senior students help fresh students with both adaptation and integration.





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The project participants also got acquainted with the work of the King Sejong Institute, which is strongly represented in the MRU.

The second day of the visit started with the results of the survey of project participants, which took place on the first day of the visit. According to the survey, all universities have a structural unit that is responsible for promotion, teaching-studying process, international students adaptation. There was also a brainstorming on the experience of interaction and adaptation of international students into a new environment for them.

The presentations prepared by representative of the Marketing Department proved that the problem of using adequate SMM tools in promoting the university and attracting potential students abroad is relevant and very important.

During the question-and-answer session, Dmytro Nikytenko asked Audra Dargyte Burokiene, how the MRU addresses the issue of determining the minimum sufficient number of students in groups and what the MRU does if this minimum number is not achieved.

Also on this day there was a meeting of project participants with the Ambassador of Ukraine to the Republic of Lithuania Volodymyr Yatsenkivskyi. Possible steps of cooperation between educational institutions of Ukraine, the Embassy of Ukraine in the Republic of Lithuania and Lithuanian educational institutions were discussed at the meeting.

The session with the Head of the PhD and Doctoral programs Department, who shared the experience about the peculiarities of their preparation, requirements to the scientific work and opportunities for students to participate in research projects in which MRU is a participant, in particular in the context of sustainable development, was very useful.

The third day of the study visit was also dedicated to the mechanism of advertising of potential international applicants in Lithuania and Vilnius in particular. Thanks to the program "Go Vilnius", international students can learn essential information about Lithuania in an easy and accessible form.

Students from Turkey Hatice Dindar, Emine Ozmen and from Austria Christian Helzlwimmer, who came MRU within the credit mobility program, shared their experiences of adapting and integrating into the university environment, as well as what they do now as mentors to adapt new university students.

The next event was at the Center for Civic Education, which is located on the territory of the Presidential Palace. This is a real modern digital center that educates a citizen of his country, who has knowledge about the history and modernity of his/her country. The exhibit-model was the distribution of state budget expenditures and the possibility of adjusting the share of certain components.

The fourth day of the visit began in an unusual format. The student mentors, who we met on the third day, showed in practice how they conduct a tour in Vilnius. We saw the Cathedral of St. Anna, climbed the Gediminas Tower, took a walk in the Benedictine Gardens, experienced the authenticity of contemporary art in the cultural quarter of the Republic of Užupis and completed the tour in the Town Hall Square.





In general, the following conclusions can be drawn about the study visit to the Mykolas Romeris University:

1. It is essential to use information technologies at the stage of application and registration of international entrants.

2. All the participants learned how to optimize and structure administrative procedures that will improve the integration of international students into the new environment.

3. Best practices of a roadmap for the adaptation of international students creation were analyzed with the aim to implement at the home university.

4. Conducting an adaptation course for the enrolled international students is of the need.

5. Actively use of modern SMM instruments and relevant social networks to promote the university abroad will make your university effectively visible.

6. A set of organizational measures for smooth integration and adaptation of international students is important.

7. Involvement of state institutions in the process of adaptation and support of university initiatives aimed at attracting international students will help to increase the number of international students at the university.

We would like to extend our sincere gratitude to the MRU staff who prepared such an informative visit and shared their experience in the adaptation and integration of international students.







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#### **News from OPSU**

# The Odessa Polytechnic State University delegation visited Mykolas Romeris University in Vilnius



The INTERADIS project aims to expand and improve the Ukrainian higher education institutions' capacity to adapt and integrate international students. The project is co-financed by the European Union's Erasmus + program and supported by the Erasmus Office in Ukraine.

The project program included this first offline visit of Ukrainian partners to Mykolas Romeris University, Lithuania.

The Odessa Polytechnic State University delegation included the Educational and Scientific Institute of Foreign Students Training representatives and the International Students Dean Office.

The Lithuanian Erasmus+ National Agency representatives acknowledged the Ukrainian and European project partners about the possibilities opened by the Erasmus+ program to promote partnership and mobility between Lithuania and Ukraine, introducing their details on the national statistics of such exchanges at the current stage.

A wide range of international students' admission and marketing procedures have been discussed. In addition, Lithuanian colleagues shared practical experience of integration activities next to the international students' arrival at the university.





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Also, the event participants had in Vilnius a meeting with the Ambassador of Ukraine to Lithuania Volodymyr Yatsenkivsky, who expressed his will to render assistance in that cooperation, shared his ideas and advice on work in the diplomatic sphere as well as on partnership with Lithuanian colleagues.

The delegation assessed that experience gained from European colleagues as very useful for the successful implementation of the INTERADIS project and the embodiment of the internationalization concept at our university, improving the educational environment for international students.

### Information meeting of the participants of the study visit from Odessa Polytechnic National University to the Netherlands Business Academy



On November 29, 2021, an information meeting of the participants of the study visit to the #NLBA of the Netherlands Business Academy (Dordrecht, the Netherlands) took place on November 22-26 within the framework of the EU-funded #INTERADIS project with the Vice-Rector for Research and Teaching and International Relations Shobik V. S. The best practices of adaptation and integration of international students at the Dutch Business Academy were discussed at the meeting.

Among the issues discussed were the following:

- Analysis of personality, as well as personal behavior and character
- International communication





- Student experience
- Feedback exercises
- Negotiation and conflict management
- Integration and communication
- Action research
- Identification of distinctive qualitative characteristics of the individual

The seminar participants identified the priority steps to improve these processes at Odessa Polytechnic National University #OPNU, as well as the next steps in the implementation of the INTERADIS project.



# Delegation of the National University "Odessa Polytechnic" visited the Netherlands Business Academy (Dordrecht, the Netherlands)

According to the project program, from November 22, 2021, to November 26, 2021, the second offline visit of Ukrainian partners to the #NLBA of the Netherlands Business Academy (Dordrecht, the Netherlands) took place.

The delegation included the Educational and Scientific Institute representatives for the Training of Foreign Citizens of Odessa Polytechnic National University #OPNU (Saveliev A. A., Kunitsyn M. V.).

The #INTERADIS project aims to expand and improve the capacity of Ukrainian higher education institutions to adapt and integrate international students. The project is co-financed by the European Union program #ErasmusPlus and is supported by the Erasmus Office in Ukraine #ErasmusUA.

During the study visit, primary attention was paid to the analysis of personality, personal behavior, and character, identification of distinctive qualitative characteristics of personality. In addition, particular





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attention was paid to international communication and the integration of international students. Also, exercises were held with feedback and testing the technology of negotiation and conflict management to expand and improve the quality of integration.



The experience gained from European colleagues will be helpful for the successful implementation of the INTERADIS project, the performance of the concept of internationalization, improving the educational environment for international students at our university.

#### Presentation of the results of the study visit of Interadis project participants to Mykolas Romeris University (Vilnius, Lithuania)

On November 11, 2021, an interdepartmental scientific-methodical seminar was held at the Institute of Foreign Citizens Training of Odessa Polytechnic National University #OPNU, where a report on the implementation of the international project #INTERADIS was presented at the institute. To Mykola Romeris University, Vilnius, Lithuania #MRU.

Speakers shared the experience of Lithuanian colleagues with the complexity of integration activities after the arrival of international students at the university and for the entire period of study, told about





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the practice of integrated IT technologies for attracting, accepting, administering, and integrating international students. Social networks as the main tools in the process of admission and training and sharing common impressions about the coworking zones spread throughout the university.



Summing up, the project stressed that this project allows not only to expand the geographical opportunities for sharing experiences but also to gain valuable practical skills in open dialogues with colleagues from different countries, which improves the educational environment for international students and improves the concept of internalization and adaptation of international students at our university.

# Presentation of the results of the study visit of Interadis project participants to the Netherlands Business Academy (Netherlands, Dordrecht)

On December 2, 2021, a meeting of participants of the international project #INTERADIS from the Institute of Foreign Citizens Training "Odessa Polytechnic" #OPNU was held to present the results of a study visit to the Netherlands Business Academy #NLBA. The main speakers (Saveliev A. A., Kunitsyn M. V.) gave the visit program and a thorough presentation on each program item. During the report, it was noted that #NLBA representatives took a non-trivial approach to draft the project and considered internationalization not as separate measures for foreign nationals but as a generalized problem of interpersonal relationships in a multicultural society. Therefore, they did not start from the specifics of a foreign citizen's stay in a non-cultural environment but from the characteristics of each participant in





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a multicultural environment in terms of overcoming barriers between individuals during the interaction.



Of course, all presentations, workshops, and pieces of training were based on European practices widespread in the Netherlands in general and in the NLBA in particular. Nevertheless, according to the speakers of this meeting, many ideas, approaches, and methods can be effectively used at the stage of language preparation of foreign citizens to join the Free Economic Zone, which should help establish constructive and effective relations between participants in the educational process.
